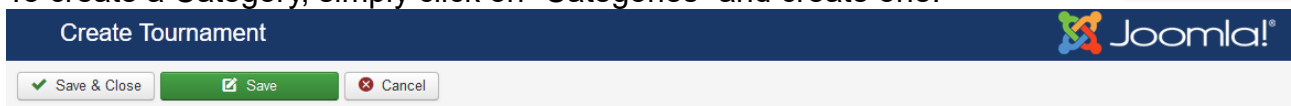

3. Register Players for the Tournament

- click in the column "Participant" on (here) "10 Player". An empty list opens.
- Click on "Add" (= add players) at the top-left of the Joomla-window.

There are two ways of registering players:

3.1. Enter Player by Name

Fill in the provided form (see right side of this window) and click on "save" (green button on the top-left).

3.2. Add Players from the Grading Lists of the Clubs

- select a chess club from the drop-down-list
 - The list of members of this club will be displayed (see screenshot below)
 - Tick the players of this club you want to register for your tournament
 - click on “save” or “save and close”
 - repeat this procedure since all places are full
 - you can delete and add players
 - you can increase the number of players by clicking on the button “Number of Players + 1”
- List of all players of a chess club (here: Aigburth Chess Club).

3.3. A Player is not a Member of a Chess Club

It is possible to register a player for the tournament, who is not a member of a chess club. This player has to be registered manually (see paragraph 3.1).


Alternatively you may create a club called “uncategorised” and register all players, which are not members of any chess club but play in tournaments, in this club “uncategorised”. Then this players are available as members of “uncategorised” (see: “select club”).

3.4. List of Players of the Tournament

You can sort this table by clicking on the name of a column (blue) or by clicking on the arrows (chevrons).

The Start Numbers are important not only for an all-play-all tournament with regards to the FIDE-Pairing-tables, but in particular for a Swiss-Tournament (CH-Tournament). You have the options to set the Start Numbers at random or Start Numbers according to the ranking list of the players or Start Numbers according to the TWZ.

Remark: The TWZ is the “Tournament Rating Number”. You are free to set the TWZ for every player of your tournament.

You can always edit and change the pairings manually.

If you use the CH-System (Swiss System) for this tournament, only the pairings of the first round have been created; after the first round you can create the pairings of the second round using a CH-System-Programm like e.g. Swiss Chess or Sevilla, and so on.

A player gets a “bye”:

- click on the green button “add one pairing” at the top-left of the Joomla-window. Now change the match. A player with a bye has no opponent “- Select Player (Black) -” or “- Select Player (White) -” and select “bye” as the result.

PGN-files: It is possible to publish the games.

- create the PGN-file of a game; comments are possible

- click in the column “PGN” in the row you want to the game on the “0”:

6. Rounds, settings

To manage the settings of a round, click in the column “Rounds” on e.g. “6 Rounds” and then in the column “Round” on e.g. “Round 1”.

7. Publishing the Tournament

Navigate at the Joomla-backend to: “Extensions/Modules” and open the “CLM Modul Turnier” (see column “Type”).

- Choose a category, if necessary
- Click in the field “Tournaments” and add your tournament to the list
- Choose the parameters for all the other settings
- Publish this module.
